

Nagarkot Chisapani Trek With Kathmandu, Bhaktapur Sightseeing - Itinerary

1. Day 1: Arrival in the Kathmandu [Altitude 1340 m]

Arrival at the Tribhuvan International Airport (TIA), Kathmandu and will Welcome by our airport representative and transfer to hotel and shortly briefing about program - Overnight stay at the hotel

2. Day 2: Explore Kathmandu and hike to Chisapani

After breakfast Kathmandu drive to - Sundarijal around 1 hours trek to Chisapani (2300M) takes about four and half hours. The trail will enter through the Shivpuri Watershed and Wildlife Reserve. The first settlement you will come across is Mulkharka with Tamang habitants. The route heads down the ridge through a forest of oaks and rhododendron to Chisopani (2300m.). Overnight at teahouse

3. Day 3: Hike to Chisapani to Nagarkot

Nagarkot (2175M)Trek from Chisapani to Nagarkot takes about six and half hours. Your trek starts to Chauki Bhanjyang, which takes about 2 and half hours. You continue the charming trails leading you toward Nagarkot. Nagarkot, (2175m) is by far one of the most popular destination. In the clear weather the Himalaya range, stretching from Dhaulagiri in the west all the way past Everest to Kanchenjunga in the east. Overnight stay in Nagarkot

4. Day 4: See Sunrise view and Drive to Kathmandu via Bhaktapur Durbar Square

See the beautiful sunrise view in the morning after breakfast drive to Bhaktapur city of devotes Bhaktapur Durbar square to see ancient royal palace and drive back to hotel in the evening join especial cultural show dinner program - Overnight stay in Kathmandu

5. Day 5: Departure to airport

Departure to airport Today is your last day in Nepal free time until departure transfer to the international airport for final departure we hope to see you again soon.
